

Santiago / Corralco / Pucon

Post Trip Extension to Torres del Paine (Patagonia)

ITINERARY

DECEMBER 11, 2020 – Arrival Santiago



Arrival early morning. You will be met by a CoddIWomple Journeys English-speaking guide who will assist you with your transfer to the hotel. Check in upon arrival (early check available at additional cost)

The remaining day is at your leisure.

Accommodation: Hotel Cumbres Lastarria

Meals Included: None

DECEMBER 12 – Santiago – Corralco

After breakfast, transfer to airport to board your domestic flight to Temuco. Upon arrival you will be transferred to your hotel in Corralco. Spend the rest of the afternoon at leisure as you enjoy the surroundings of the hotel as it's part of Ski resort. At sunset we will meet on the terrace to enjoy the sunset with pisco sour and do a talk about the exciting days ahead of us. Later, dinner will be served at the hotel restaurant (alcoholic beverages not included). After dinner there will be an activity coordinated by the hotel (Karaoke, Bingo) or you can choose to retire early.

Accommodation: Hotel Corralco.

Meals Included: Breakfast, Light Lunch, Dinner

DECEMBER 13 – CORRALCO



After breakfast depart for an excursion to Navidad Crater and Mirador de los Volcano. A small crater was formed on December 25, 1988 during the eruption of Volcano Lonquimay.

From the crater we will go on the road to Lolco to reach the viewpoint where we can observe the unique landscape shaped by years of volcanic activity. Later return to the hotel. A picnic lunch will be served in Mirador de los Volcano.

In the afternoon, enjoy the hotel facilities such as swimming pool, sauna and jacuzzi. Dinner will be served at the hotel restaurant. After dinner depart on a short trekking excursion to East Millenary Araucaria. You will see one of the oldest araucarias (evergreen coniferous trees) and its diameter and height will dazzle any visitor. Return to the hotel for a briefing of the eclipse the next day.

Accommodation: Hotel Corralco.

Meals Included: Breakfast, Picnic Lunch & Dinner

DECEMBER 14 – Corralco / Eclipse Day

After a leisurely breakfast, we will begin preparations to see the total solar eclipse. There are 5 sites around the town of Pucon. Coddiwomple Journeys is reviewing with local authorities and the final determination will not be made until early 2020. We will be driving about 3 hours south from the hotel to get closest to the center of the path of totality.

The day will start early to account for traffic conditions and be able to get to the viewing site on time. Refreshments, boxed lunches, non-alcoholic beverages etc will be provided. The total eclipse will be at 1:03PM. After the eclipse ends, we will drive 3 hours back north to the hotel. After freshening up, we will have dinner as a group at the hotel and celebrate our time together.

Disclaimer: Seeing a total solar eclipse is dependent on clear, sunny skies and favorable weather conditions. If cloud cover or rain is forecasted for the day, you will not see the eclipse like you would on a clear, sunny day. Coddiwomple Journeys will not be held responsible for unfavorable weather conditions. Coddiwomple Journeys will ensure the viewing site is located within the upper and lower band of the eclipse path.



Note: The program for this day will remain flexible as we have to consider several logistical factors. Our main purpose is to ensure we get the group to the most optimal eclipse viewing site.

Traffic conditions could result in longer drive times to and from the hotel and eclipse viewing site. The day will be long as we will plan to depart the hotel early morning and will not return till late evening. During the day, Coddiwomple Journeys will try to make sure we offer the most comfortable experience possible given the remote location we will be in.

All Hotels in the area are fully booked, however, we are on a waiting list for hotels near Pucon so we don't have to drive back up to Corralco Hotel. However, there is no guarantee we will find one, so please assume we will be driving back north to our hotel for an overnight stay.

DECEMBER 15 – Pucon

After a leisurely breakfast and a little later start in the morning, we check out of the hotel and drive 3 hours to the town of Pucon, known for its lakes, hiking trails and adventure activities, as well as Villarica Volcano. After arriving at our hotel in Pucon, we will have lunch. Rest of the afternoon at your leisure. Dinner will be on your own as you explore the town of Pucon and its many restaurants.

NOTE: We can have a late start in the morning to allow for more time to rest after a tiring previous day traveling to see the eclipse.

Accommodation: Hotel Malalhue

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch

DECEMBER 16 – Pucon

After breakfast we drive an hour to Huerquehue National Park where will trek the Los Lagos or Lakes Trail. Some attractions you will come across the trek will be: Nido de Águilas and Trifulco Waterfalls; two viewpoints overlooking Lake Tinquilco and Villarrica Volcano, and the beautiful lakes Verde, Chico, Toro and Huerquehue. This trail will take you through Mañío forest with short leaves, Coigüe, Lenga, Araucaria; beautiful ferns and varieties of fungi, lichens and mosses. It is a 3.5 hour moderate hiking trail and approximate 12 kms. A box lunch will be provided during our lunch break.



Once finished our bus will take us back to Pucon. Dinner will be on your own.



Accommodation: Hotel Malalhue

Meals Included: Breakfast & Box Lunch

DECEMBER 17 – Depart For Santiago / U.S

After breakfast you will transfer to Temuco airport to board your return flight to Santiago. Most US bound flights depart late at night, so we will arrange day rooms near the airport hotel so you can rest for a few hours before you check in for your international flight. A shuttle to and from the airport to the hotel is available. You will be transferred to the hotel upon arrival and at your scheduled international check-in time be driven to the airport.

Accommodation: Hilton Garden Hotel or Holiday Inn Airport Hotels – Day Use Room

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch (at Airport Hotel)

DECEMBER 18 – Arrive In US

Arrive back to the US in the morning.

Extension To Torres Del Paine (Chilean Patagonia)



DECEMBER 17, 2020 – Puerto Varas

After breakfast we depart Pucon and drive to Puerto Varas (5 – 6 hour drive). Check in to your hotel for one night. We will have to stay one night due to the long distance and connect the next morning to a flight to Punta Arenas, a city on the tip of Chile's southern most point in Patagonia and the base to depart to Torres del Paine, the heart of Chile's Patagonia region.

Accommodation: Hotel Cabanas del Lago

Meals Included: Breakfast, Boxed Lunch, Dinner

DECEMBER 18: Punta Arenas

After breakfast, transfer to the airport near Puerto Varas for your domestic flight to Punta Arenas. Upon arrival in Punta Arenas, you will be met by your guide and transfer to your hotel in Torres del Paine National Park (4.5 hour drive), this trip will be a shared transfer with other passengers staying at the hotel. You will have the afternoon free at leisure to enjoy the surroundings of the hotel and get to meet the guides.

The hotel is all-inclusive and you will have all meals included and excursions are managed by professional guides who are experts in the region. When you arrive at the hotel, you will be able to sign up for a full day or two half day excursions for each day of your stay. Guides will be on



hand to assist you based on your interests. Boxed lunch will be provided if having a full day tour or a full lunch if you do two half day tours. Dinner served at hotel.

Note: There is a new airport being constructed in the town of Puerto Natales which the government of Chile claims will be ready by December 2020. If this is the case, we will fly to Puerto Natales instead of Punta Arenas as it cuts the travel time to Torres del Paine in half (2 hours).

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Your signature on our tour reservation form will signify your agreement with the following terms and conditions.

Introduction:

These are the terms and conditions applicable to the tour packages provided by CoddIWomple Journeys LLC (collectively "CoddIWomple Journeys", "we", "us" and "our"). The terms "client" "you" and "your" refer to each person who purchases and/or uses a tour package provided by CoddIWomple Journeys .

Benefits of Tour Packages:

Our tour packages offer services of a professional tour guide, accommodations, meals as outlined in the itinerary, transportation as specified in the itinerary and excursions and tours as outlined in the itinerary.

CoddIWomple Journeys may, from time to time, offer you optional services or benefits. By using those services and/or benefits when they become available, you agree to be bound by any supplemental terms applicable to those services or benefits We will send final documents and tickets by overnight or registered mail approximately two (2) weeks prior to the start of the tour.

Rates and Exclusions:

The rates and charges for tour participation are those established at the time the tour is booked with CoddIWomple Journeys . We reserve the right to increase tour prices to cover increased costs, tariffs, taxes and V.A.T. received after prices are published and to reflect fluctuations in foreign exchange markets. Published rates and charges are typical "per person," based upon double occupancy with en suite bath (unless otherwise stated). Single rooms are subject to a single room supplemental charge which is stated in the proposal. Expenses and terms not specifically identified in the applicable CoddIWomple Journeys produced quotation are not covered. These include any paperwork or charges associated with: passports, visas, immunization, meals other than those specified, optional excursions, trip protection coverage, alcoholic beverages (beer, wine and liquor), all beverages excluding those provided in CoddIWomple Journeys vehicles, telephone calls, room service, laundry, personal items, baggage handling, international airfare unless otherwise stated, gratuities and transportation to or from any departure gateway and any other costs that might be incurred not stated in tour package. Some governments charge departure taxes and/or fees. These fees are the responsibility of each passenger traveling to the designated country and are not included unless stated.

Payment. We accept the following forms of payment: major credit cards, bank transfer or checks drawn on a U.S. Bank. Credit cards will incur a service fee of 3-5% paid by the client.

You must promptly pay the following fees and charges for participation in an CoddIWomple Journeys tour.

Airfare: Full payment per person is due in order to purchase airline tickets. Airline cancellation policy shall apply. Discounted airfare quote (if available) is subject to purchase of ground package.

Ground Package: A non-refundable deposit of \$1,100 per person per tour is required immediately to secure the tour and services.

Balance: The balance of the tour price is due 120 days before departure.

Revisions:

A fee of \$125 per booking for each change made sixty (60) days or more prior to the start of the tour. The cancellation fees set forth below apply to changes made less than sixty (60) days prior to the start of the tour.



Cancellation by You:

We must receive your cancellation notice in writing by email, fax, or overnight courier, and your cancellation date will be the date on which we receive your notice. Simultaneously with your notice, you must pay the following cancellation charge based upon the amount of notice provided. In addition, airline cancellation policies shall apply for cancelled tours involving air transportation:

There is no refund for unused portions of a tour once it has commenced, and you are solely responsible for costs incurred by you due to missed, canceled or delayed transportation. Your decision not to participate on the tour due to State Department warnings, fear of travel, illness or any other reason will be deemed a cancellation. If a flight or other delay for any reason prevents you from joining the tour on the tour departure date and time, you will be considered a no-show, and we cannot provide a full or partial refund or credit toward a future tour, but you may join the tour late if you wish.

Insurance:

CoddIWOMPLE Journeys recommends that you purchase trip cancellation, medical, and baggage insurance to cover penalties and cancellation charges. Please contact CoddIWOMPLE Journeys if you wish to purchase such insurance. However, any questions about what travel insurance does or does not cover should be addressed directly to the travel insurance company. If you decline insurance coverage, you will personally assume full responsibility for any financial loss associated with your travel arrangements, and you could lose your travel investment and/or have to pay more money to correct the situation.

Cancellation or Substitution by Us:

We will make commercially reasonable efforts to keep the itinerary as it has been published; however, the final itinerary may vary due to availability and factors beyond our control. We may in our sole discretion substitute services such as hotels or goods of similar quality for any service or good stated in the itinerary. If a tour is cancelled, our liability is limited to a full refund of your payments, and we will not be liable for any other costs, damages, or refund of any kind for any loss, delay, inconvenience, disappointment, or expense whatsoever in such circumstances. If for reasons beyond our control, a tour in progress must be interrupted or cancelled, we will refund a portion of the price depending on our actual costs incurred.

Study or Group Leader(s) (if applicable): Participation of a Study or Group Leader(s) is dependent on obtaining the minimum required number of full-paying travelers registering for the trip. In the event the minimum number is not met, we have the right to either cancel the trip for a full refund OR run the trip without a Study or Group Leader(s). In the event the Study or Group Leader(s) cancel their attendance on their own merit, we will make every attempt to substitute with another Study or Group Leader(s), without guarantees. We will not be liable for any other costs, damages, or refunds of any kind for any loss, delay, inconvenience, disappointment, or expense whatsoever in such circumstances.

Airfares:

Airlines and airfares included in any brochure are subject to change without notice. Please check with CoddIWOMPLE Journeys or your travel agent for conditions applicable to your airline ticket. Even after you have paid, tours with scheduled air transportation within or from the United States are subject to supplemental price increases that may be imposed by the supplier and/or government. You hereby consent to any such price increase. We will not change your requested seat assignments on commercial aircraft without permission. Passports and Visas:
